

PPE TECHNICIAN COURSE



PPE Programs are a required part of the organization's comprehensive Injury Illness Prevention Program and shall provide for the proper use, proper training, and proper

maintenance of PPE. This course has 5 goals; provide the education and practical skills training necessary to allow the organization to develop, implement, and manage a PPE Program for all PPE elements; identify and explain the regulatory requirements of OSHA and OSHA plan states regarding the selection, use, training, and maintenance of PPE; identify and explain related regulations and national consensus standards that are also associated with PPE Programs; discuss best practices intended to control exposure issues resulting from cross contamination; last, this course concludes with providing the student with the training & documentation as required by the 2014 edition of *NFPA 1851 Selection Care & Maintenance of Protective Ensembles for Firefighting*.

This course has been completely updated for 2018 to include compliance information from OSHA applicable to all PPE as well as providing content specific to structural and proximity firefighting PPE. This is a 24-hour, instructor led course structured using a module approach and uses a learning style that incorporates both lecture and practical training. While this course provides valuable information to students at any level, this course is intended to be a management level course and provides the FD-HSO, PPE Program Manager and the PPE Technician with the subject matter expertise to support the organization's PPE Program to include use/training and maintenance requirements. Topics include mandated standards & regulations; terminology & definitions; exposure control requirements to prevent cross contamination of apparatus, station, personnel, and public; safety of maintenance personnel; roles and responsibilities of senior management, the HSO, PPE Program Manager, and the Firefighter. For NFPA 1851, this course provides the required training and documentation on inspections, garment testing, and cleaning as well as industrial cleaning best practices, suggested equipment, and proposed updates for the 2019 revision of NFPA 1851.

Course material will include:

- Senior Management, HSO, PPE Committee Members, PPE Program Managers, and personnel with PPE responsibilities.

- It provides the student with a working knowledge of mandatory regulations and standards (OSHA, EPA, NFPA) that are applicable to PPE Programs.
- It provides guidance on why and how to protect apparatus, facilities, and personnel from PPE exposed to dangerous contaminants.
- It provides guidance on how to protect personnel performing PPE maintenance.
- It provides guidance on the necessary resources to perform proper PPE maintenance.
- It trains and documents personnel IAW NFPA 1851-2014

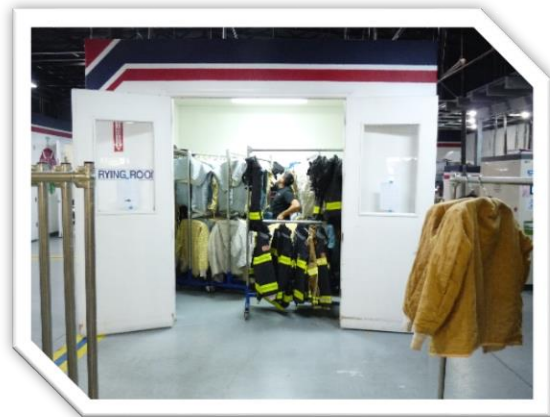
